Since its inception, MWWA has worked to address the needs of its members. The association has evolved over the years and has taken a more active role in legislative and regulatory advocacy on behalf of water professionals statewide.

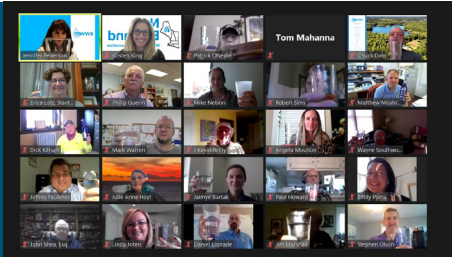
Recent efforts include grassroots outreach to legislators through “legislative coffees,” testifying at legislative hearings on issues of importance to the water works industry and getting an amendment passed in the state budget to create a “Blue Ribbon Panel” to study the effectiveness of the Water Management Act.
