This course reintroduces the topics covered within the initial 8-hour certification; certification must be renewed every 5 years. This class will provide an understanding of:

- Types and uses of asbestos and identification of the material
- The nature of asbestos-related diseases and routes of exposure
- Review of applicable federal and state regulations regarding asbestos.
- Review of the updates made to MassDEP's AC Pipe Guidance Document
- Proper AC Pipe Work Practices including final visual inspection and waste disposal procedures and related reporting forms

Attendees must successfully pass a multiple-choice exam to receive certification. This course is approved for **3.0 TCHs** (Training Contact Hours) for Massachusetts water and wastewater operators and RI drinking water operators. It is taught using the Zoom platform. Participants must have a reliable, highspeed internet connection, and a computer device with both video and audio capability.
