FROM ROUTE 3:

Take Route 3 South to the Sagamore Bridge rotary. Bear right on Route 6 without going over the bridge to East Buzzards Bay rotary. Go $\frac{3}{4}$ of the way around the rotary and bear right on Main St. to first set of traffic lights. Turn left, you are now on Academy Drive. The fair will be located in Admiral's Hall in the Harrington Building.

FROM ROUTE 495:

Take 495 South to Route 25 East. Take the second Buzzards Bay Exit (Exit 3, right before the Bourne Bridge). Go $\frac{3}{4}$ of the way around the rotary and bear right on Main St. to first set of traffic lights. Turn left, you are now on Academy Drive. The fair will be located in Admiral's Hall in the Harrington Building.
