

Preparing Your CCR – Things You Should Know Remote Training Using Zoom

The annual requirement for public water systems to provide the Consumer Confidence Report (CCR) to their customers can often seem overwhelming. Organizing the sample data, formatting the report, and trying to distribute the document in the most cost-effective manner can be a daunting task for many. This half day class will provide attendees with an overview of the current requirements of the CCR as well as EPA's proposed changes. Information on some of the MassDEP tools available to help public water systems will be provided. It will also include valuable tips on how to efficiently prepare and distribute the CCR.

This is a valuable refresher for staff familiar with the CCR and is a **MUST** for new staff needing to understand the critical aspects of the preparing and distributing the CCR.

Learning Objectives:

- Review the current CCR requirements and the proposed EPA changes.
- Learn about the tools MassDEP has to help prepare the CCR.
- Discuss some useful dos and don'ts when preparing and distributing the CCR.
