

Concepts & Practices of Drinking Water Distribution – Remote Zoom

This 12-week State-approved course is designed to introduce the concepts of drinking water distribution operations. Taking and passing this course is a pre-requisite for taking the Drinking Water Licensing Exam(s) for Water Distribution, grades D2, D3, or D4 and it is a required component for eligibility as an operator-in-training or a full license operator.

Participants will learn required information and critical thought processes involved in understanding the successful operation and maintenance of drinking water distribution systems. Topics include: Regulatory Compliance, Types and Installation of Pipes, Valves, Meters & Pumps, System Hydraulics, Worker Safety, System Security, and Administrative Duties.

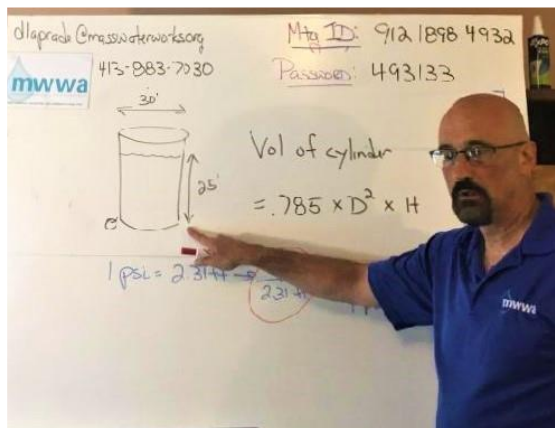
Basic Math Knowledge is required for this course. If you are not comfortable with math concepts you should consider taking a math course before taking this course.

This course is taught remotely using the Zoom teaching format. All students must have a reliable internet connection and a computer device with both audio and video capability. An optional practice Zoom session will be scheduled for anyone using Zoom for the first time. All classes are recorded and made available to the students. Students that successfully complete the course will received a signed a State-Approved “Certificate of Completion” along with a Training Contact Hour Certificate for up to 37 hours. Passing this course requires attending at least 10 out of the 12 sessions and obtaining a minimum of 70 points which is achieved through a combination of attendance, homework, mid-term and final exam grades.
