Position Purpose:

The purpose of this position is to be responsible for the safe and efficient operation of the water treatment plant which may entail equipment maintenance and inspection; use of laboratory testing equipment; analysis of adjustments needed to maintain water quality and record keeping. An individual in this position is also expected to perform many different types of maintenance work and manual labor. A Water Treatment Plant Operator is responsible for maintaining and improving upon the efficiency and effectiveness of all areas under his/her direction and control. This individual must be able to work independently.

Required Qualifications:

Must have a High School Diploma or GED, 1 year of water treatment plant operation experience preferred; or any equivalent combination of education, experience, and training. Minimum Water Treatment License T1 is required, must have the ability to obtain Water Treatment License T2 to operate the plant unsupervised.
