

Operations Service Technician Chelmsford Water District

The Chelmsford Water District (District) is looking to fill the position of Operations Service Technician. The Operations Service Technician is an integral part of the District operations. The Operations Service Technician will be responsible for installing, repairing, maintaining, operating, or otherwise ensure the safe and efficient production and distribution of drinking water and fire protection.

This is a permanent full-time position and will work Monday through Friday and may be subject to call out to respond to emergencies after normal working hours. Position has expectation to go on a scheduled rotating on call after a probationary period. Wages will be commensurate with experience and licensure but range from \$22/hr. for entry level up to \$30/hr.

The District has excellent benefits which have a positive impact on pay as follows:

1. 100% paid health, and dental plan coverage.
2. Full reimbursement for tuition and educational materials
3. Annual stipends for project related activities.
4. Paid vacation time, personal day, sick leave, and bereavement.
5. Thirteen paid holidays.
6. Middlesex County retirement pension based on years of service, once vested.
7. Boot/clothing allowance.

The candidate must have the following characteristics:

1. High School diploma or equivalent.
2. Retain a valid driver's license. Ideal candidate would retain a CDL Class B license.

The desirable candidate will have the following characteristics:

- 1) Experience in drinking water industry construction and operation, but willing to train the right individual.
- 2) A Distribution D1 license.
- 3) Licenses or characteristics which are considered a plus are as follows. The District supports training to obtain these licenses.
 - a. Distribution D2 or D3 or higher.
 - b. Valid hoisting license for operating an excavator (2A) or backhoe (2B) and similar license for forklift (1C).
 - c. Backflow testing and survey license.
