Responsibilities: Works under the direct supervision of the Director and/or Working Foreman. Required to operate any motor driven hydraulic equipment owned or leased by the department, including front end loaders, backhoe, any type of scoop or road grading equipment and hoisting equipment. Also operates snow plows, sanders, dump trucks and operate motor equipment of a lower level of difficulty. Greases, oils, cleans and performs preventative maintenance on equipment. Performs manual labor tasks and any other duties deemed necessary by the Director and/or Working Foreman. Must be available for emergency calls beyond regular working hours as needed.

Qualifications: Commercial Drivers License – Class B with air brake endorsement required or CDL permit to receive CDL within 6 months of date of hire. Massachusetts Hoisting Engineer License required with the ability of running backhoes, front end loaders and excavators. Candidates should have a minimum of 3 years of experience in operating hydraulic equipment capable of operating backhoe and loader. Knowledge in performing winter operations and be able to lift fifty (50) pounds, with or without accommodation. Strong ability to communicate effectively, along with being punctual and dependable. Bilingual skills preferred but not required.
