**RESPONSIBILITIES:** Under the direction of the Water Utility Director or Supervisor, the Working Foreman's duties include the overall maintenance and ongoing inspection of department motor equipment including gasoline and diesel internal combustion engines, fuel injection equipment, electrical systems and all winter equipment such as plows, sanders & skid loaders. Responsible to troubleshoot, repair and perform preventative maintenance on all motor equipment on a regular basis as needed and as scheduled. Other duties include welding; metal work; assembly and disassembly of diesel and gasoline engines; tune ups; removal and replacement of faulty parts. Also will oversee a crew consisting of Motor Equipment Repair people. The Working Foreman must sustain a positive work relationship with other employees as well as professional interaction. Other manual labor tasks and duties are carried out as needed and required by the Director or Supervisor. Must be available to work emergency calls after regular work shifts.

**QUALIFICATIONS:** Current Commercial Driver's License - Class B with air brake endorsement required. Strong ability in effective communication skills along with being punctual and dependable is a must. Minimum of 3 years of experience as a master auto/truck mechanic with demonstrated mechanical knowledge of sanding/plowing duties a must. Must be able to obtain CDL driver's license and ASE certification within 6 months of employment. Required to own auto mechanic tools/box.
