All candidates shall be adept at written/oral communications; completing assigned tasks; time management; critical thinking and analysis; attention to detail; the practical application of math to solve real world problems; and the use of digital applications including spreadsheets, word processing, and presentations. At a minimum, candidates must demonstrate a can-do spirit, an ability to work well with others, a willingness to learn and an aptitude for both hands-on and office work. Proficiency with environmental technology, earth science, engineering or GIS preferred; construction or maintenance experience is also a plus.
