



## **WATER OPERATOR/TRAINEE**

**The West Boylston Water District is accepting applications for the full-time position (40-hour 5-day week M-F) of drinking water operator/trainee.**

Applicants must have a minimum of a HS Diploma or equivalent. Possession of a MA D1/T1 drinking water supply license or the ability to obtain one within two years is a condition of employment. MA D2/T2 license is preferred along with any other related drinking water/backflow qualifications. Education, training, and testing will be provided.

Self-motivated, responsible, hardworking, and physically fit people able to lift to 70 pounds, who will perform the duties and functions as listed in the job description are encouraged to apply. Experience in the drinking water supply field is preferred.

The successful candidate must:

- 1) Be available for weekly on-call duty rotation, including nights, holidays, and weekends, and must be able to respond and be on-site within thirty minutes for emergencies.
- 2) Possess a valid MA drivers license and be physically capable of operating motor vehicles in a safe manner and maintain a good driving record.
- 3) Pass a pre-employment physical exam, including a drug/alcohol test.
- 4) Pass a criminal history background check.

We offer competitive wages based on qualifications starting at \$22/hr. with minimum qualification and \$28/hr. with full qualifications.
