Wastewater Treatment Operator

The Charles River Pollution Control District, a regional medium-sized advanced wastewater treatment facility, designed to treat 5.7 MGD, is seeking a candidate for the full time position of Wastewater Operator.

The position requires that the successful candidate possess or obtain within six months of hire at least a Grade 4M Massachusetts Wastewater Operator License, on the job training and classes will be provided.

Candidate will also be required to possess or obtain a 2A and 3A Massachusetts Hoisting License within the first six months of hire. Training will be provided.

Responsibilities (not a complete list of duties)

- oversight and operation of treatment plant equipment
- making adjustments to plant processes to maintain permit compliance
- recording readings of instruments and plant equipment
- operation of the sludge thickening process
- oversight of chemical deliveries
- assisting other departments as needed

Skills and Abilities

- minimum high school diploma
- interpret process data and make adjustments to maintain permit compliance
- work well in a team-oriented environment while also being able to work independently
- be safety conscious
- use a computer to access and make changes in SCADA, perform data entry into the process control computer software database, etc.
- understand/execute written and oral instructions and read/understand technical instructions and manuals
- operate equipment specific to Departmental needs and requirements, after receiving training
- complete physical tasks, including but not limited to, pulling or lifting 50 lbs, climbing a ladder and performing confined space entry

Weekend, holiday shifts and on-call are required, additional compensation will be provided.

Hourly rate ranges from \$20/hour - \$27/hour and will be based upon experience and qualifications. Valid driver's license required.
