

Utility Specialist

The Littleton Electric Light & Water Department is seeking applicants for a Utility Specialist to perform construction, maintenance and servicing of the Littleton water and sewer systems. After a reasonable training period, the successful candidate will be required to participate in the weekly on-call rotation, which requires the ability to respond to after-hours emergencies at any time of day or night for one week out of every six.

Position works under the direct supervision of the Water & Sewer Operations Manager. This is a union position with starting pay between \$25.27 and \$32.70 per hour, dependent on qualifications, with regular opportunities for overtime. Desired qualifications include water and/or wastewater treatment experience, a Class B CDL, and a MA Hoisting License. Benefits include a four day work week (10 hour days, Monday through Thursday), enrollment in the Massachusetts Public Pension System, 12 paid holidays per year, 2 weeks' vacation per year, 12 sick days per year, and 24 hours of personal time per year.
